NEW contour option for Wiedenmann UK's Super 500

New for 2010, Wiedenmann introduces an optional super contour following kit for the Super 500. This comprises a multiple roller which fits inside the rotor drum, bringing the anti scalp wheels even closer to the centre of the rotor drum so they follow contours more accurately.

Golf course managers and local authority buyers have long been fans of the Wiedenmann Super 500 because it's the archetypal multi-tasker. They know by investing in this one machine it can be used for sweeping, leaf collection, verticutting or flail mowing, depending on attachments employed.

"We're expecting to take guite a few orders for the new option as it can be retro-fitted." says Chas Ayres, Wiedenmann UK Sales Manager. "Despite the economic slow down the Super 500 is one of those mowing and collecting stalwarts - we've just installed three in Scotland, two to golf courses and one to a college."

In any mode the Super 500 produces a high airflow; collected material is always well compacted. The forceful vacuum and gutsy 2500 litre hopper combine to leave a professional clean finish every time. The 2.1 metre high dump facility on the CHD model allows for easy tipping into bins and trailers and this also comes as standard on the basic sweeping model. The container lifts via a parallel system, with the hopper rotating allowing the hopper to completely discharge collected material. Working depth can be set easily and quickly from -20 mm right up to 150 mm.

The natural habitat of the Super 500 is park grounds, extensively maintained areas, ecological meadows, sports grounds and golf courses. Indeed it comes into its own anywhere where there is contoured turf. The parallelogram guided sweeper head ensures that implements maintain an optimal working position at all times. This is a key safety advantage as its floating head ensures a clean pass over undulating ground.

There is an optional floating rear axle which allows the Super 500 to tackle undulating terrain with ease. Other options include a front roller to minimise the chance of scalping; in-cab remote control to allow the operator to change the three operating functions - head unit lift and lower, hopper lift and hopper tip. Dethatching and scarifying blades can be easily fitted to the cutting head without the use of tools and can be spaced at 19mm, 38mm and 57mm centres. Road lights can be fitted

The RRP of the Super 500 SHD starts at £12,995, while the Super 500 CHD starts at £16,450 ex VAT. The super contour following kit is an additional £950.
