NEW – Terra Clean saves hours of back breaking work every day

Wiedenmann's new Terra Clean really deserves a more exciting name as this impressive machine not only picks up litter, it also returns infill back to the pitch and leaves the synthetic surface looking its best again.

Part of Wiedenmann's new range of artificial turf maintenance equipment, the Terra Clean is an invaluable asset to the busy ground care operative. While synthetic surfaces are generally low maintenance they are not without their problems. All too quickly litter and debris accumulate. Wrappers, drink cartons, animal droppings, leaves, seeds and stones all present a hazard. However, the Terra Clean can save hours of back breaking work every day by quickly and efficiently gathering them from the pitch and surrounding area.

Hidden from view inside the main unit, a robust counter rotating brush lifts surface debris into the primary hopper, placing it on a vibrating sieve. Infill granules are cleverly recycled, returned to the surface as they fall between the sieve holes. Next, so the recycled infill is evenly redistributed and doesn't form ridges, a drag brush follows on leaving an even surface. The debris meanwhile is shaken into the collector at the rear of the machine. The waste tray is then easily emptied.

With a working width of 1.2m the Terra Clean attaches to tractors 15hp and above by three point linkage and for transportation lifts up via the linkage. It is priced from £6,950.
